Terms of Hire

- All equipment must be treated with care, and returned to allocated area after use within the allocated hire period. Please take care when carrying, launching and landing or recovering across uneven ground.
- Any damage must be notified on return, normal wear and tear is acceptable, you will be liable for any damage caused by negligence.
- Aztec can accept no liability for any activity undertaken by the hirer(s), nor can it be held liable for any injury, loss, or damage to the hirer or third party.
- Aztec has the right to cancel sessions due to adverse weather which may affect the safe running of the sessions. This includes stopping any sessions that have already started.
- Sailing and Windsurfing is only available to those who can prove they have prior experience/qualifications.
- All participants must wear buoyancy aids and appropriate footwear.
- Any wetsuits, buoyancy aids that are hired or included must be returned at the end of the session and not left in the changing rooms.
- Users should stay in defined areas as instructed by staff, no swimming is allowed at anytime.
- The minimum age for participation is aged 8 years and older. Children under 8 years may participate in hire sessions as long as they share a piece of equipment with an adult aged 18 years or older. Anybody under the age of 18 must have their form signed by a parent or guardian and supervised at all times.
- All craft(s) have a risk of capsizing; Aztec will not be held responsible for any injury, loss, or damage to the hirer or third party.
- Equipment should be used correctly on sessions and treated with respect; hiring equipment should not be used as an excuse to use it as a diving platform.
- Whilst all activities and sessions are organised with the participant(s) safety first and foremost, personal insurance against accident or loss is entirely the responsibility of the participants and their parents or guardians, it must be recognised that all participants, their parents and guardians, accept the risks when they choose to partake in the activities.
- Please be aware of trees and bushes around the lakeside, please avoid as this may cause injury to participant(s).
- Safety cover - a rescue craft is available in case of emergencies, please signal to a member of staff in the event of an emergency.
- Please do not attempt any activity under the influence of alcohol or drugs including any medication.
- All lake water contains bacteria, therefore eating/drinking is not allowed while afloat, cuts and wounds should be covered before going on the water. We also suggest that you wash off lake water at the end of a session.
